

## **CERTIFICATION OF NO TAX LIABILITY**

A requirement of the City of Fort Wayne's American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (SLFRF) Grant Opportunity Application is Proof of Good Standing with the Indiana Department of Revenue (IDOR) in the form of a letter from the IDOR or a screenshot from IDOR's portal, INTIME.

However, the City of Fort Wayne recognizes that not all applicants have tax liability to the Indiana Department of Revenue (such as payroll tax or sales tax), and therefore, are not required to submit Proof of Good Standing with the Indiana Department of Revenue as part of the grant application package.

In lieu of Proof of Good Standing, the City asks applicants to certify that they do not have any tax liability and submit this form as part of their application package.

By signing this certification, I certify that the entity for which I am applying as the representative does not have any tax liability to the IDOR. I understand that I am waived of the requirement to submit Proof of Good Standing with the IDOR. I understand that falsely representing a lack of tax liability with the IDOR will automatically disqualify me from receiving funds and/or result in the revocation of awarded funds.
