## MINOR BREEDER PERMIT REGULATIONS

Any <u>owner or person having custody</u> of a dog or cat which gives birth to a litter or causes the birth of a litter is required to obtain a Minor Breeder Permit. This permit is required even if the litter is unwanted or unplanned. The permit limits the owner to one (1) litter in any twelve (12) month period. The cost of the permit is \$100.00 if female animal is already micro chipped and \$115.00 if not.

#### THIS PERMIT DOES NOT TAKE THE PLACE OF OTHER PERMITS THAT MAY BE REQUIRED BY CITY ORDINANCE!

#### **OPTIONS TO THE PET OWNER**

When your dog or cat has a litter, your options are:

- 1. Turn in the <u>entire litter</u> to the Department of Animal Care and Control, (No permit required).
- 2. Keep, sell, trade or give away the litter or any part of the litter, and have the adult animal spayed or neutered within ten (10) weeks after the birth of the litter, (**Permit required**, **\$10.00**).
- 3. Keep, sell, trade or give away the litter or any part of the litter, and turn in the adult animal to the Department of Animal Care and Control, <u>after weaning</u> (8 weeks), (**Permit required \$10.00**).
- 4. Keep, sell, trade or give away the litter or any part of the litter, and <u>do not</u> spay, neuter or turn in the adult animal to the Department of Animal Care and Control, (**Permit required \$100.00 and microchip for \$15**).

Article V, Section 6-9(5) and Section 6-10(5) state that a breeder is "required to register with the Department of Animal Control the name, address, and telephone number of each buyer or new owner of any dog or cat sold or transferred within five (5) days after the date of such sale or transfer".

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#### **INFORMATION ON MINOR BREEDER PERMIT**

You have just purchased a Minor Breeder Permit from the City of Fort Wayne Department of Animal Care and Control. Please understand that these permits are required to assist us in limiting the number of unwanted animals within the City of Fort Wayne. Each year there are countless numbers of unwanted animals that have to be killed because there are no homes for them. Included in these numbers are numerous **"PURE BREED"** animals. For this reason, you are advised of the following terms of your permit:

- This permit is for <u>YOUR PRESENT LITTER, ONLY. YOU MAY</u> <u>NOT HAVE ANOTHER LITTER OF CATS OR DOGS FOR</u> <u>THE NEXT (12) TWELVE MONTHS!</u> This stipulation applies regardless of the number of female animals you may own.
- 2. Any future litters born of this or any other animal owned by you may subject you to fines and or Court appearances. This also includes accidental or unwanted litters.
- 3. Under Fort Wayne City Ordinance, the **offering** for sale or give away of any cat or dog requires a Breeder Permit.
- 4. Under Fort Wayne City Ordinance, the breeding and selling or giving away of domestic animals is considered to be a business. Therefore, should you wish to become a Professional Breeder, it will be necessary for you to provide proof that you occupy a property that is properly zoned for such a business.
