- 2. Approval of Improvement Resolution #67085, St. Joe Dam Intake Sediment Removal.
- 3. Approval of Resolution #109-8-30-22-2, Adopting the Fifth Amendment to the Tax Sale Agency Agreement to Bid on Tax-Delinquent Properties for City Utilities.
- 4. Approval of Change Order #1 & Final between the City of Fort Wayne and RG Zachrich Construction for Resolution #76933, River Bend Bluffs Lift Station Improvements. This change order decreases the original contract price by \$16,152.14 to a final contract price of \$192,427.86 and extends the completion date by 25 days.

- 2. Approval of Resolution #109-8-30-22-1, Allowing Construction activities in the Right-of-Way of a Regulated Drain located at 1627 Laverne Ave.
- 3. Approval of Amendment #1 to Services Agreement between the City of Fort Wayne and Heartland Restoration Services for Beckett's Run Interceptor and Stream Mitigation Sites Maintenance. Compensation for services performed shall be increased by \$39,480.00, with a not-to-exceed of \$78,960.00.
- 4. Approval of Change Order #1 & Final between the City of Fort Wayne and Krafft Water Solutions and acceptance of the work performed for Contract #83646, Snowfall Rd Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation upon the recommendation of City Utilities Engineering The final change order decreases the original contract price by \$10,212.82 to a final contract price of \$77,394.18 and extends the completion date by 7 days.
