One Cart Recycling Guidelines

Not everything that is recyclable can go in your cart. Save this sheet as a guide for what can and cannot be put in your recycle cart. For more information on how to recycle items that cannot go in your cart visit www.acwastewatcher.org or call **449-7878**.



DO'S

Please rinse all containers.

Remove lids from containers and recycle them loosely in your cart. Labels do not need to be removed.



Glass bottles & Jars

Recycle brown, green and clear glass.



Plastics

Recycle plastics #1 thru #7 and styrofoam. Look on the bottom of containers for a number inside the recycling arrows.



Metal Cans, Aluminum Foil, Aluminum Foil Pans

Recycle all food and beverage metal cans - steel, tin, bi-metal and aluminum.



Cardboard, Newspaper and Magazines

You can also include newspaper inserts, catalogs, paperback books, phone books and brochures.



Paper Food Containers

Recycle food boxes including: juice boxes, egg, ice cream and milk cartons, and cereal and pasta boxes.



Paper

Recycle envelopes, office paper, junk mail, greeting cards and file folders. Shredded paper should be put in a paper bag.
