Backflow prevention is required for proposed facilities fitting the following description in accordance with 327 Indiana Administrative Code 8-10-4 (c) and the requirements of the City of Fort Wayne.

Read through each item and check the 'yes' box if the corresponding description fits your proposed facility. Check the 'no' box if your proposed facility does not fit the description.

- Checklist items with 'yes' and 'no' checkboxes: Aircraft and missile manufacturing plants, Automotive plants, Beverage bottling plants, Canneries, Car washes, Chemical laboratories, Hospitals, Metal and plastic manufacturing, Paper products, Fertilizer/pesticide processing, Commercial facilities, Oil processing, Commercial laundries, Sewage treatment, Waterfront facilities, Industrial facilities, Restricted facilities, Soft drink machines, Spec. Facilities, Secondary source of supply, Fire suppression service line.

If the 'yes' box is checked on any of the above items, backflow prevention is required. See the City of Fort Wayne Design Standards Manual – Water Standards, Chapter W8 Backflow Prevention for guidance.
