

# Aboite Meadows Storm Drainage Improvements

Project Fact Sheet

## Project Goals

1. Reduce chronic drainage issues on streets and in yards of homes in the north end of Aboite Meadows addition;
2. Replace the existing swale and culvert system within right of way areas to increase the capacity of the stormwater management system, thereby reducing yard and basement flooding; and
3. Address drainage concerns in preparation for street improvements to be made by Fort Wayne's Division of Public Works.

## Project Description

The contractor hired by City Utilities, API Construction Corporation, will construct improvements to the storm sewer system to provide better drainage along Turf Lane, Spurwood Circle, Carriage Lane, East Saddle Drive and Paddock Court. Approximately 4,000 linear feet of new storm sewer will be installed along with 15 manhole structures and 42 storm sewer inlets of various sizes.
