Dear Aboite Meadows resident or property owner:

I am pleased to inform you that Fort Wayne City Utilities has awarded a contract for construction of stormwater drainage improvements in the Aboite Meadows Neighborhood that will help to alleviate street and yard flooding on Carriage Lane, Turf Lane, and East Saddle Drive. The project involves the installation of new storm sewer pipe and storm drain inlets with the majority of the work to be done in public right-of-way and on City-owned property.

API Construction Corporation has been awarded the contract for construction of the project. Work is expected to begin in July 2018 and be completed with final restoration in the spring of 2019.

I know that utility construction projects can be disruptive for neighborhoods while they are going on. It is the goal of our staff to keep you well-informed about what is expected to happen during the project. I want you to know who to contact to answer your questions and resolve any construction issues.
