Brookside Parkerdale Drainage Improvements – Phase 1

Project Goals

- 1. Improve drainage in the southern portion of the Brookside-Parkerdale neighborhood;
- 2. Improve the existing stormwater management system and increase its capacity by replacing existing stormwater infrastructure;
- 3. Repair and regrade existing swales to help direct stormwater runoff toward the new storm sewers.

Project Description

The project is being designed to install new storm sewers in portions of the 5100-5300 blocks of Derome Drive, Rosebury Drive and 5100-5200 blocks of Ione Drive, on the 6600-6700 blocks of Canby Drive and on Garland Drive from Rosebury Drive to Evard Road. Storm sewers will be installed to serve Bradford Drive, Penrose Drive and Willow Brook Drive and will be sized in preparation for other improvements in the future. There will also be water main replacement in some areas where storm sewer work is planned to mitigate utility conflicts.
