

Hessen Cassel Road Storm Drainage Improvements, Phase 1 & 2

Project Fact Sheet

Project Goals

1. Improve drainage along Hessen Cassel Road from Oxford Street south to the City limits to reduce street flooding and improve stormwater quality;
2. Create a constructed stormwater detention/retention area to reduce standing water west of Fairlane Avenue.
3. Add sidewalks along Hessen Cassel Road to improve connectivity and provide safer pedestrian access.

Project Description

In order to move into construction more quickly, the project has been divided into two phases. Phase 1 will focus on Hessen Cassel Road from Oxford Street south to Stardale Drive. Phase 2 will continue improvements along Hessen Cassel from Stardale Drive to the City limits. The design will include a mix of open drainage swales (shallow ditches), new storm sewers and inlets, and constructed but natural basins to receive and hold stormwater during wet weather.

Project Time Line

June 2018 – Review preliminary design with residents
September 2018 – Construction bids received by Board of Public Works
Fall 2018 – Construction begins
