

# Karen & Kingsley Storm Drainage Improvements

## Project Fact Sheet

### Project Goals

1. Improve the local stormwater drainage system to protect homes from flooding on Karen Avenue and Kingsley Drive in the Glenwood Park neighborhood;
2. Replace an area of concrete street surface on Karen Drive west of Reed Road.

### Project Description

A total of almost 1,400 linear feet of new storm sewer will be installed in two separate areas and will connect with an existing storm sewer that was built in 2016. In addition, 21 new storm sewer manholes and inlets will be installed and 240 linear feet of concrete street will be replaced.
