Dear Maplewood Park property owner or resident:

I am pleased to inform you that Fort Wayne City Utilities has awarded a contract for construction of a stormwater drainage improvement project in your neighborhood. The project will improve and add to the existing stormwater management system to reduce street, yard and basement flooding.

Included in the project is the installation of approximately 3,700 linear feet of 12" to 30" diameter storm sewer pipe, installation of 54 new drainage inlets, grading of approximately 2,800 linear feet of roadside ditch and replacing driveway culverts. Seventeen existing drainage structures that are either failing or undersized will be removed and replaced. Work will be done on Woodcrest Drive, Kenfield Drive, Lawnwood Drive, Brooklawn Drive, Springwood Drive and at the intersection of Springwood Drive and Kirkdale Drive.

Rothenberger Company has been awarded the contract for construction of the project. Work is expected to start in early 2018 and be completed in the fall of 2018.

I know that utility construction projects can be disruptive for neighborhoods while they are going on. It is the goal of our staff to keep you well-informed about what is expected to happen during the project. I want you to know who to contact to answer your questions and resolve any construction issues.
