Dear Resident or Property Owner:

Fort Wayne City Utilities is developing a design for a stormwater improvement project along the Schoppman Drain between Stellhorn Road and Harris Elementary School. The purpose of this project is to improve drainage in the Tamarack neighborhood and reduce street flooding on Innsbruck Drive and Ottawa Drive.

City Utilities engineering staff members would like to meet with you to show you the plans for the project and answer questions you may have. The project scope consists of improvements to the County-regulated Schoppman Drain from the bend at Harris Elementary school upstream to Stellhorn Road. The proposed design includes removal of an existing 24" pipe and creating an open ditch system in its place. Connections between the existing stormwater management system and the Drain will be improved and some clearing and cleaning is planned for the upper portion of the Drain between Stellhorn Road and Albert Drive. City Utilities is working closely with the Allen County Surveyor's Office on plans for the project.
