Fort Wayne City Utilities is making progress on a design for improvements to the Schoppman Drain between Stellhorn Road and Harris Elementary School. The purpose of this project is to improve drainage in the Tamarack neighborhood and reduce street flooding on Innsbruck Drive and Ottawa Drive. We appreciate the insights shared by neighbors when we met in early March, and we are ready to provide an update and show you what has been designed.
