

St. Croix Drive Drainage Improvements

Project Fact Sheet

Project Goals

1. Stop erosion and stabilize banks of the ditch south of St. Croix Drive between Cherrystone Court and Hobson Road in the Sanibel Acres addition;
2. Improve drainage on Cherrystone Court.

Project Description

To reduce erosion and stabilize approximately 300 feet of the ditch that runs between homes south of St. Croix Drive, City Utilities is proposing to install turf reinforcement mats that are frequently used in high-flow channels and along stream banks where protection is needed from water and wind. The turf mat will help vegetation grow along the upper part of the bank. The lowest portion of the ditch bank, known as the toe, will be armored with rip-rap. The project will also include a short storm sewer extension and the addition of one storm sewer inlet on the east side of Cherrystone Court.

Project Time Line

August 2018 – Review plans with affected property owners
September 2018 – Receive bids
Late fall 2018 – Construction begins
Spring 2019 – Construction complete including final restoration
