Dear Wyandotte Drive area property owner or resident:

I am pleased to inform you that Fort Wayne City Utilities is planning for construction of a storm sewer project in your area that will improve drainage along Wyandotte Drive (from South Drive to North Drive) and portions of Ferndale Drive, Oakpark Drive, North Drive and South Drive.

The project will involve the installation of approximately 3,000 linear feet of new storm sewer pipe ranging in diameter from 12 to 24 inches, 32 new drainage inlets and seeding and grading.

Ironclad Excavating has been awarded the contract for construction of the project. Work is expected to begin before the end of this year and be completed in late spring of 2017.

I know that utility construction projects can be disruptive for neighborhoods while they are going on. It is the goal of our staff to keep you well-informed about what is expected to happen during the project. I want you to know who to contact to answer your questions and resolve any construction issues.
