- Examine the possible savings to the taxpayers by vacating current space utilized by City and/or County departments off-site.

GOVERNMENT SERVICES SPACE ALLOCATION STUDY CITY OF FORT WAYNE + ALLEN COUNT










# FETY IN CITY COUNTY BUILDING

# TOTAL COST: \$15,732,680



- Strong Public Safety functional ties to the County Courthouse
- Lock-up holding facilities with tunnel access
- **Better proximity to County Jail**
- City County Building currently contains other elements of Public Safety
- 911 and Omni Room as emergency command capacity
- City County Building currently contains passive security features not present and easily attainable at East Berry Building
- main facility floor level provides enhanced security Significant elevation difference from surrounding street level to
- 0 security Distance of building setback from street frontage for enhanced
- 0 Ability to control lower level entry for secure, discreet building entry
- 0 Ability to utilize and control adjacent parking structure for Public

### Cons:

- Public Safety spread on multiple floors in 9 story tower-similar to Creighton Street configuration
- Requires relocation of more functions than Scheme B. "Double move" required for this scheme- Public Safety cannot be relocated until City County Building is cleared.

# East Berry Street Building for Public Access

### Pros:

- floor plates Allows for co-location of other common City and County functions on large
- Building type more amenable to office functions
- Scheme allows for a strong, integrated Management Team, placing City and County leaders adjacent on Third floor west

## Cons:

Separates development-related functions from the property tax-related functions

# **City-County Building for Public Access**

**Pros and Cons:** 

- Most departments are able to remain in current locations, move costs minimized
- Management-related functions and property tax-related functions in the same building
- and County leaders adjacent on Second floor Scheme allows for a strong, integrated Management Team, placing City

# Cons

Separates Development Team from other functions

# East Berry Street Building for Public Safety

### Pros:

Allows for large, adjacent floor plates for Public Safety functions, enhancing collaboration

### Cons

- Passive security features not present in East Berry Street Building
- 0 Proximity of building face to curb line
- 0 Ribbon windows facing street
- More difficult to create secure/ discreet entry ports Tactical units

0

- Detective squads/ undercover operations
- More difficult to create secure parking arrangement
- Costs for securing the facility more than Scheme A
- Continues the separation of City Police and County Sheriff operations from 911 and Lock-up holding area, Omni Room emergency command
- Less proximity to County Jail
- Lacks holding facilities and access to County Courthouse
