- **Aboite Lake Estates Association** - \$5,000 to repair signposts and install newly branded signage.
- **Arlington Park Association** - \$5,000 to add new playground equipment to community playgrounds.
- **Brierwood Hills** - \$5,000 for landscaping and bench restoration at community entrance.
- **Broad River Neighborhood Association** - \$5,000 for planting 100 street trees.
- **Concordia Gardens Community Association** - \$5,000 for new playground equipment at park.
- **Crestwood** - \$5,000 to paint new crosswalks for pedestrian safety.
- **East Central Neighborhood Association** - \$4,986 to install new fencing and gates for the community garden and food pantry.
- **Eastside Neighborhood** - \$5,000 for a new mural, signage, and landscaping.
- **Fairfield Neighborhood Association** - \$4,630 to install waste bins and dog waste stations.
- **Hamlets of Woodland Ridge East** - \$5,000 for a new entrance sign and branded street signs.
